REACH AROUND

Small Groups: While our church continues to grow larger, we desire to grow smaller by involving our members in Small Groups. Small Groups encourage each of its members to grow in Christ through the study of God's Word, prayer, worship, fellowship, and outreach projects. The following Small Groups are available to choose from: **Sermon-Based Small Group** (allows in-depth discussion and study of our Pastor's weekly teaching); **Men's Small Group** (Bible-based topical or chapter-by-chapter studies for men where "iron sharpens iron"); **Women's Small Group** (Bible-based, topical or chapter-by-chapter studies for women); **Golden Girls** (a fun loving, on the go group from seasoned women who are at least 50 and above); **Refuge Small Group** (a vibrant fellowship of young adults ages 18 to 30-ish).

REACH OUT

Outreach Projects: Our Small Groups support a variety of outreach opportunities such as: **Bundles** which provides outreach to the homeless, those who are in transition, and those who have been displaced abroad and are seeking refuge here in the states; **Calvary Chapel Rescue Mission** which blesses the men at the Peninsula Rescue Mission with meals, God's Word, and fellowship.

ADDITIONAL AREAS OF SERVICE

First Impressions: First impressions are lasting ones, and our **Parking Lot Team, Greeters/Welcome Center Team,** and **Ushers** want your first impression of CCNN to be a great one. These teams are the first smiling faces you see as you enter our campus and facilities. Whether it's providing assistance with walking and/or carrying items to and from your vehicle, giving you information about upcoming events, helping you find a seat, or simply saying "hello," First Impressions' number one goal is to be ambassadors for Christ while making your experience at Calvary Chapel Newport News an enjoyable one.

Calvary Café offers refreshments before and after our Sunday and Wednesday services. Proceeds from the Café will go towards supporting building projects and completing classrooms in Phase 5 in our Youth Ministry building.

REACH UP

Worship Team: Through song and music, our worship team helps us prepare our hearts to receive God's Word and to worship the Lord.

Prayer Ministry: Prayer is a vital necessity for the well-being of our Fellowship and is our church's power source. The **Altar Prayer Team** is available at the end of each service to pray for and with members and guests. The **Intercessory Prayer Team** stands in the gap for CCNN's members, ministries, pastors, staff, and guests and seeks God's will for the church. There is also **corporate prayer** through our Small Groups, Women's, and Men's gatherings. **Prayer E-Blasts** are also another way the church comes together to pray for the needs of our members.

What Calvary Chapel Believes:

GOD THE FATHER God the Father, who is the Creator & Ruler of the universe eternally exists in three persons: Father, Son & Holy Spirit. (2 Cor. 13:14, 1 Cor. 2:10, Heb. 9:14)

JESUS CHRIST Jesus Christ is co-equal with the Father and is the foundation and cornerstone of the church. He came to restore man's broken relationship with God. His finished work on the cross made that possible. Because He demonstrated His love on the cross by dying for our sins, we now have reason to fellowship with one another and proclaim salvation through His life, death, and resurrection. (1 Cor. 3:11, Eph. 2:20, Rom. 5:6-10)

HOLY SPIRIT The Holy Spirit is co-equal with the Father and the Son of God. He is present in the world to make men aware of their need for Jesus Christ. He also lives in every Christian from the moment of salvation. He provides the Christian with power for living, understanding of spiritual truth, and guidance in doing what is right. He gives every believer a spiritual gift when they are saved. As Christians, we seek to live under His control daily. (John 14:16-17, 16:7-13; Acts 1:8; 1 Cor. 2:12, 3:16; 2 Cor. 3:17; Eph. 1:13, 5:18; Gal. 5:25)

What we believe continues...

SALVATION Salvation is God's gift to us, but we must accept it. We can never make up for our sin by self-improvement or good works. Only by trusting in Jesus Christ as God's offer of forgiveness can anyone be saved from sin's penalty. When we turn from our self-ruled life and turn to Jesus in faith, we are saved. Eternal life begins the moment one receives Jesus Christ into his life by faith. (John 1:12, 14:6; Rom. 5:1, 6:23; Gal. 3:26; Eph. 2:8-9; Titus 3:5)

BIBLE The Bible is the inspired, infallible Word of God and is relevant and applicable to man today. Therefore, we place great emphasis upon teaching it in public, studying it in private, and using it as a guide for our daily lives. (Acts 20:32, 2 Tim. 3:16-17, 1 Thess. 2:13)

WORSHIP We believe God is worthy of all praise, reverence and love. We take special time to worship Him in the church with song. It is our goal to worship Him with our whole lives as well: at home, at work, and at play. (John 4:23, Col. 3:16, 1 Thess. 5:16:18)

CHRISTIAN GROWTH Our supreme desire is to know Christ and to be conformed into His image, likeness, and example by the power of the Holy Spirit. We encourage this by abiding in Jesus Christ through His Word, prayer, fellowship and by yielding our lives to the Holy Spirit in order to grow and bear witness to His Name. (John 15:5, Rom. 8:29, Eph. 4:15)

LOVE Love is the greatest virtue and demonstration of the reality of Jesus Christ. We endeavor to show a Christ-like love toward all men. Love should be exhibited in our lives by our words as well as our actions. (John 13:34-35, 1 Cor. 13:13, Phil. 2:3-5)

CHRISTIAN SERVICE Christian Service is a part of the Christian life and is the responsibility of all Believers. Our goal is to develop the ministry of every member to the benefit of all. (Eph. 4:11-13, 1 Cor. 12:4-7)

SECOND COMING We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ is coming to the earth again, to claim His own people and to set all things in order. (John 14:1-3, 1 Thess. 4:13-17, 1 Cor. 15:20-28)
